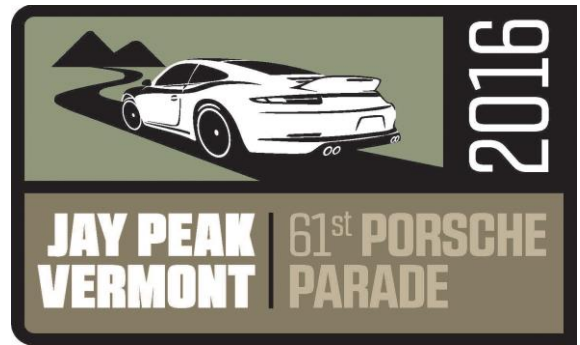

“The Belfry” <http://thebelfryvt.com> (a funky old school house, small, great food, & seafood) on 242

“The Big Jay Tavern” <http://www.bigjaytavernvt.com> (casual, great food, check “about” on website), also on 242, and both Belfry and Tavern are just a few miles south of resort on 242 in the direction of, but before Montgomery Center.

On the Main St. in Montgomery Center, there is **“Bernies”** <http://berniesvtfood.com> (a casual family restaurant, a local hangout for good food. Mexican nights on Monday & Thurs, do not be put off by the looks from the outside),

and of course **“the Inn”** also on the Main St. <http://www.theinn.us/>

On the Jay Side of the Mountain, at the Jay intersection, is the **“Jay Village Inn”** . <http://www.thejayvillageinn.com> (good food, casual, large portions). These 5 above are all near to the resort and good choices for “off nights” or for those arriving a day or 2 early. Except for the Inn that would prefer a reservation, the rest either do not require or don’t take reservations.
